FINANCIAL POLICY SUMMARY

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Our Status

World Outreach is a Mission Agency, which exists to mobilise workers for God's harvest and to assist them to be as effective as possible for Him. We are a registered charity but because of our off-shore focus, gifts given to missionaries are not tax deductible in most countries.

Our Operation

We do have organisational overheads and require operational finances to cover costs of pastoral care, the finance department, fundraising activities and publicity for ministries through the Nations magazine and website. Operational finances are obtained by donations from supporters of the organization, grants from Trust Funds as appropriate and a 10% levy on all funds donated for our workers and their ministries. The levy helps WO to serve the missionaries and is also a commitment by our workers to partner with us in the ministry of mobilisation.

Our Workers

Our cross-cultural workers are expected to raise 100% support prior to departing from their home country. Their specific support figure is dependent on travel costs, location/living costs, marital status and family size. The figure for any given field is determined by those who know best – the host team (or a team nearby). All personal finances raised by each worker are available for their own use.

Donations for Ministry purposes or Projects are to be recorded separately from Personal Donations. The use of Ministry Funds will be decided in conjunction with Field Leadership.

Fundraising

We have a partnership approach to fund raising. We offer to work with new candidates to determine the best way of promoting their need for funds. We can help develop a promotional brochure highlighting his/her background, vision and intended ministry. The National Director can draft a personal letter to the appointee's contacts endorsing his/her call and importance to the field, and encourage the recipient to consider supporting the appointee(s) through prayer, financial support, or other practical ways as determined by the appointee(s). A response slip is developed and included.

Accountability

Supporters and donors rely on the organisation to hold workers accountable for using funds with integrity. Hence Financial Reports are required to be submitted for all ministry donations, and also a total of funds received and used for personal needs. The sending National Office also holds an up to date list of all supporters who receive communication from our cross-cultural workers.
